Grant Success for our Club.

In the recent months we have applied for several grants to help set up the Club for WPG projects and to better our ability to teach new skills and to help us make our upcoming Rally the best it can be.

We have been fortunate enough to secure \$27,,500 for tooling and metalworking equipment which we have bought to make tinware, cooling tanks, guards, and various other needed bits for our restorations.

New equipment includes Lathe, Sheet Metal folder, guillotine, bead roller, sheet curver/roller, dollies, Tool chests, specialist tools and the such.

We have also secured 2 other grants totaling just under \$10,000 which will enable us to have our rally as a free entry event and pay for the Tractor Pull sled hire and team, the portable toilets and other essential infrastructure that we need.

We are eternally grateful for these grants as they will benefit our club no end, both in allowing us to host a spectacular event, enabling entry to those who would not normally show interest and bettering our skills, abilities techniques and restorations.




126th Lakegold Smith Steam & Vintage Rally 2025

Lyam, I and my camera ventured down to Beaufort for the 126th Lakegold Smith Rally that was featuring the 100 years of caterpillar. On the way there we detoured to Mt Gambier, stopping and spending time at the sink hole gardens as well as the blue lake. With a late night arrival at Max Lewis's shed and a rough set up while raining hoping the days ahead would be perfect. Saturday morning rolled around, we woke up to the smell of steam and traction engines rolling past, a beautiful alarm clock if you ask me. During the 3 days spent at the rally Lyam and I were able to have the opportunity to operate a Fowler Z7 plowing engine, 6hp simple fowler traction engine, 8ph compound fowler traction engine, a roundabout balance plow and the local Bob and Bruce's Sentinel steam wagon. We also went and looked at the saw mill demonstration multiple times throughout the 2 days as well as the steam shovel working throughout the 2 days. They were both so mesmerizing to watch work and do its thing, definitely the steam shovel was one of my favorites. Lyam and I are super grateful for being given the chance to operate all of these amazing machines.

The Caterpillar display was also amazing ranging from graders and the massive range from cat 10s to a D11 definitely well displayed.

The name Goolwa is thought to be an Aboriginal word meaning "elbow"</p> <p>European Settlement - Captain Charles Sturt's expedition in 1829-30 led to the first formal contact with the region</p> <p>River Port - Goolwa was Australia's first inland port, established in 1853;</p> <p>Railway - The Goolwa to Port Elliot railway was the first railway in Australia with iron rails, built to allow goods to move from river boats to sea boats. The spread of railways to inland led to the decline of river trade and Goolwa's importance as a Port.</p> <p>The inner part of Goolwa was declared a State Heritage Area in 1987.</p>






